CELL PHONE USE POLICY

Over the last several weeks we have noticed an increase in the use of cellular phones amongst our cadets. This has created unnecessary distractions for our cadets and our instructors during classes. As a result, we are implementing the following policy regarding the use of cell phones in the hopes of creating a better learning environment and promoting face-to-face social interactions.

Cellular phones can be a valuable communication tool for Cadets and Adult Staff. However, they can also become a distraction and negatively affect training if improperly used. The following guidelines will govern the use of cellular phones on cadet activities:

- *Cellular phones may be used by Adult Staff and Staff Cadets during cadet activities. However, the use of the cellular phone should be limited and used to aid in the performance of their duties.*
- *Junior Cadets are not permitted to use their cell phones during training hours including during transition times between classes unless they are authorized by the Training Officer.*
- *Cellular phones for junior cadets shall be turned off when entering the cadet corps and shall be kept in the cadet's backpack or a trouser pocket. Cellular phones can be turned back on at the end of the training session.*
- *Parents needing to contact their child during our normal training sessions should call our main phone number 514-630-1321 unless otherwise directed. In the event of an emergency, we will contact parents directly.*
- *Cadets who violate this policy will have their device taken to the Orderly Room where it may be picked up the end of the training session.*
- *Cadets who repeatedly violate this policy will be subject to additional corrective measures in accordance with our existing policies governing conduct and discipline.*

POLITIQUE D'UTILISATION DES TÉLÉPHONES CELLULAIRES

Au cours des dernières semaines, nous avons observé une augmentation de l'utilisation des téléphones cellulaires parmi nos cadets. Cela a créé des distractions pour nos cadets et nos instructeurs pendant les cours. En conséquence, nous mettons en œuvre la politique suivante concernant l'utilisation des téléphones cellulaires dans l'espoir de créer un meilleur environnement d'apprentissage et de promouvoir l'interaction sociale en personne.

Les téléphones cellulaires peuvent être un outil de communication de valeur pour les cadets-cadre et le personnel adulte. Cependant, ils peuvent aussi devenir une distraction et affecter négativement la formation s'ils ne sont pas utilisés correctement. Les guides suivantes régissent l'utilisation des téléphones cellulaires pendant des activités des cadets :

- *Les téléphones cellulaires peuvent être utilisés par le personnel adulte et les cadets pendant les activités des cadets. Toutefois, l'utilisation du téléphone cellulaire doit être limitée et servir à l'accomplissement de leurs tâches.*
- *Les cadets juniors ne sont pas autorisés à utiliser leur téléphone cellulaire pendant les heures d'entraînement, y compris pendant les périodes de transition entre les classes sauf autorisation de l'Officier d'entraînement.*
- *Les téléphones cellulaires des cadets juniors doivent être éteints lorsqu'ils entrent dans le corps des cadets et doivent être conservés dans le sac à dos ou la poche du pantalon du cadet. Les téléphones cellulaires peuvent être rallumés à la fin de la session d'entraînement.*
- *Les parents qui ont besoin de communiquer avec leur jeune pendant les séances d'entraînement normales doivent appeler notre numéro de téléphone principal 514-630-1321, à moins d'indication contraire. En cas d'urgence, nous communiquerons directement avec les parents.*
